## VHS TSSA Proposal 2025-2026

Goal 1 Academic	Valley High School will increase proficiency by 2% on all state assessments in ELA. Valley High School will be at or above the state average on all state assessments in Math and Science from Spring 2025 to Spring 2026.
Target Areas	ELA, Math, Science
Measurements	Student progress will be measured by Utah Aspire Plus (UA+), RISE from spring 2025 to spring 2026, and ACT for our 11th grade students.
Action Steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A. Accelerated Reading to help our general student population to increase their ELA performance and comprehension.</li><li>B. Pre-ACT assessments for 9th and 10th grade students to help assess college readiness in ELA, Math, and Science</li><li>C. Brainpop to supplement science, social studies, math, English, engineering/technology, health, arts, and music. It will be used as both a tier 1 supplement and a more targeted tier 2 and tier 3 for struggling students.</li><li>D. Staff will be given professional development opportunities related to planning, instruction, assessment, tier-1 instruction, classroom observations at other schools, PLC/data meeting observations, and behavior intervention strategies. These opportunities may be administered by the school, district, state, or professional consulting organizations. Money to be used toward travel, fees, registration, and other expenses required as a necessity of travel and/or attendance of professional development. This includes hiring substitutes.</li><li>E. Supplement a science teacher salary to ensure a wide variety of science courses are available to our students.</li><li>F. Read 180 interventions to help our students increase proficiency and close gaps.</li><li>G. Solution Tree PLC to help teachers make data-driven decisions to make improvements in the classroom instruction</li><li>H. "One Book, One Community" Event on February 25 and 26 featuring Ruta Sepetys. A Lithuanian-American writer of historical fiction. She is a #1 New York Times and international bestseller, winner of the Carnegie Medal, and has been honored by The American Academy of Arts and Letters.</li></ul>
Goal 2 Behavior	Valley High School will increase the percentage of students who report that "I feel welcome at this school" and "I feel safe at this school" by at least 5% from BOY to EOY.

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Notes for Mr. Wood:

- D. Professional Development-Due to the small school size and lack of PLC teams/networking opportunities, teachers will have an opportunity to visit classrooms in the district or potentially in the region to gain/share new ideas. Potentially bring in a present on PLC's to help look at data using the 4 questions of a PLC. Potentially use those funds to travel to PLC conference if no presenter is available.
- G. The majority of the funds are coming out of Trustlands. This is just to supplement the shortfall.
